Presentation

This master degree is based on Alfred Adler's Psychology (Contemporary Adlerian Psychology). Adlerian Psychology focuses on the meaning of life and the sense of community as the cornerstones of mental health. The main objective of this postgraduate degree is to train professionals in Adlerian psychological counseling with the skills to work with people seeking advice on emotional problems that cause discomfort or psychological suffering (personal crises, conflicts, breakups, losses, difficulties in family coexistence, work stress, life transitions, etc.)

This program is supported by the Adler University of Chicago (USA) and the International Committee of Adlerian Summer Schools and Institutes (ICASSI). There is an agreement with the Spanish Association of Adlerian Psychology (AEPA), the Latin American Association of Adlerian Psychology (ALAPA) and the Galileo University of Guatemala.

The course lasts two years and consists of 60 ECTS:

Spanish version: 40 ECTS in an asynchronous virtual way and 20 ECTS (practical training) in a virtual synchronous way that take place during 20 weekends throughout the two years on Saturday and Sunday from 4.00 PM to 8.30 PM (time from Madrid). See published calendar.

English version: 40 ECTS in virtual asynchronous mode, 16 ECTS (practical training) in virtual synchronous mode that take place during 16 Sundays and 18 Wednesdays evenings over the two years, in addition to 2 face-to-face weekends at the FPCEE Barcelona; See published calendar.

Addressee

Bachelors, diploma holders or university graduates related to the field of social sciences, education or health. Graduates and bachelor's degree holders in Psychology are preferred, while the rest must prove previous knowledge in Adlerian Psychology/Positive Discipline.
